Main Street, Upton
(Temporary Prohibition Of Through Traffic)
Order 2026-21733

NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council intends to make an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Main Street, Upton as lies between Green Lane and Heritage House.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this order.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Main Street, Upton; Nora Wood Way; Alconbury Hill, Alconbury Weston; Vinegar Hill; Hamerton Road; Hamerton Road, Upton; Upton Hill and vice versa.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate communication pipe repair and associated works which are being carried out on or near this highway.

It is anticipated that these works will take place between 2 November and 4 November 2026, when the restriction is expected to be in operation.

The Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months from the date it comes into effect to permit the works and any associated contingencies including delays or phased delivery of the works.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.

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
